

CIF-San Diego Board of Managers Investigation Update

On October 28, 2009, the CIF-San Diego Section Board of Managers -- the school superintendents of San Diego County -- met and voted to establish an ad hoc Committee consisting of the current chair, past chair, vice chair and two additional members of the San Diego Board of Managers to select an impartial investigator to review complaints about the inequitable application of CIF bylaws in the CIF-San Diego Section.

On November 12, 2009, the committee agreed to retain an outside investigator from the law firm of Best, Best and Krieger to conduct a review of the CIFSDS transfer and eligibility policies and procedures for fairness, consistency, and transparency.

The following tentative timeline was established:

- I. By November 12, 2009, the Chair of the CIF-San Diego Board of Managers will meet and confer with the members of the Committee to select the investigator. (Completed)
- II. By November 13, 2009, the Chair of the CIF-San Diego Board of Managers will contract with the selected investigator. (Completed)
- III. By November 19, 2009, the Chair of the CIF-San Diego Board of Managers will contract on behalf of the CIF-San Diego Section with the selected investigator. (Completed)
- IV. Between November 19, 2009 and January 19, 2010, the investigator will conduct his/her investigation and prepare a tentative report.
- V. At the January 20, 2010, CIF-San Diego Section Executive Committee meeting, the investigator will present their tentative report.
- VI. The report shall be presented to the full CIF-San Diego Board of Managers at the February 2, 2010 CIF-San Diego Board of Managers meeting.
